

Figure 1 – ‘1a - 4a’ show differences in association between rural and urban areas (Table 2, models 1d – 4d). The lines show modelled association between travel time and alarm symptoms (1a), emergency admission (2a), Dukes stage (3a) and three year survival (4a). 1b – 4b show the difference in the rural vs. urban slope along with 95% CI. These differences are statistically significant where the confidence intervals do not cross the zero line
